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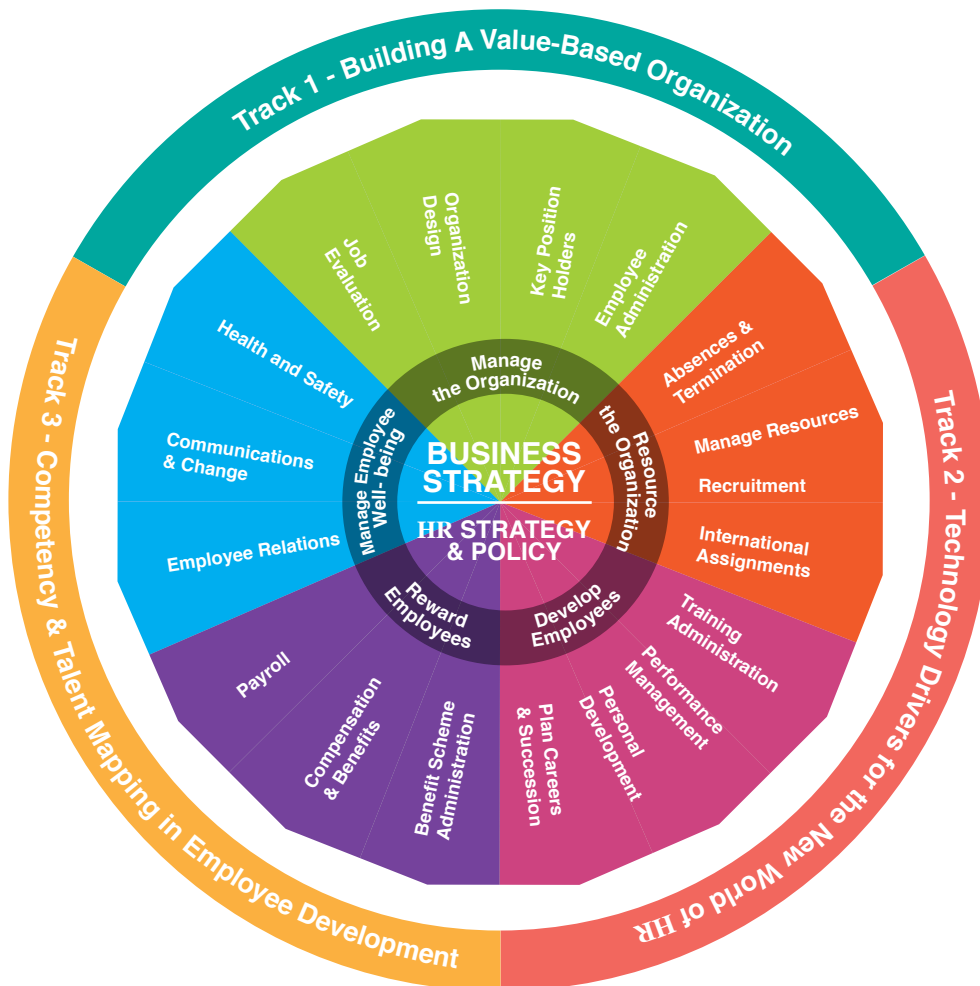


## WHY THIS CONFERENCE?

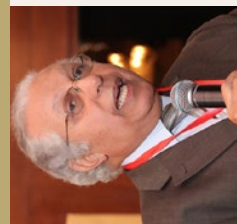

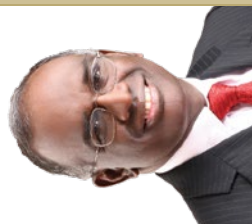

**Track Brief:**

In the wake of scandals in recent years involving high profile organization, there is a growing call for corporations to focus on value-based organizational development with the prime objective of generating business sustainability through relationship development.
